

Ebrain clinical lead

1 Introduction

- 1.1 ebrain is a project of the Joint Neurosciences Council. (JNC)
- 1.2 The JNC is a UK registered charity. The JNC objectives include neuroscience education, ebrain is designed to support this objective.
- 1.3 ebrain's objectives are to provide neuroscience education as broadly as possible
 - 1.3.1 in UK and worldwide
 - 1.3.2 to all relevant professional groups including but not limited to clinicians, nurses, allied health professionals and undergraduate students.
 - 1.3.3 using electronic means or any other educational medium

2 Clinical lead

- 2.1 ebrain is led by a team of clinical leads
- 2.2 The clinical leads are appointed by and directly responsible to the JNC board
- 2.3 The clinical leads
 - 2.3.1 provide leadership
 - 2.3.2 maintain the quality and currency of the educational content
 - 2.3.3 develop new ideas and content as required
 - 2.3.4 promote and distribute ebrain materials
 - 2.3.5 liaise with partner organisations
- 2.4 The clinical leads are supported by module editors, authors and such contractors as are required and can be afforded by JNC to run the ebrain programme.
- 2.5 The clinical leads should be appointed to reflect the different user groups from a broad range of
 - 2.5.1 specialties
 - 2.5.2 employment roles
 - 2.5.3 geographic locations

3 Appointment and Departure of clinical leads

- 3.1 The clinical leads are appointed through a competitive process following wide advertisement of the role.
- 3.2 The JNC may choose to permit partner organisations to appoint a clinical lead to represent the interests of that organisation where the partner organisation provides at least 33% of the costs of ebrain.
- 3.3 The clinical leads are appointed for a term of 4 years which may be extended by a maximum of 1 year by the JNC board
- 3.4 A clinical lead may be removed from office by the JNC board. The board must be quorate and a majority vote is required.
- 3.5 A clinical lead who wishes to resign their post must give three months notice in writing to the JNC president. This is to allow the JNC board time to find a replacement.
